Breeding Sheep All stock presented for sale must be accompanied by a declaration of medicinal treatments and any withdrawal period. This form was sent to all vendors entering sheep, please bring it with you.

MV Accredited Sheep – By prior arrangement only. A signed, current accreditation certificate must be presented before unloading at the designated bay.

All Sheep All sheep must be correctly tagged. It is helpful that all sheep are identified in their selling lots on the movement licence (numbers, coloured marks, breed, type etc.).
