7. The Auctioneers reserve the right to use their discretion without giving reason to refuse any bid, withdraw any lot or combine lots and in the case of dispute to resell the lot.
8. The auctioneers act in all respect only as agents for the vendor. All lots are accepted for sale by Gisburn Auction Marts Ltd on Condition that the vendor warrants his right to sell the same. The vendor shall indemnify the auctioneers and the purchasers against all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, charges and expenses which they may sustain or incur by reason of any defect in the vendors title. No guarantees are given or implied.

RESERVE PRICE

9. The vendor shall be entitled to place a reserve price. Such reserve shall be advised to the Auctioneers in writing no later than 9am on the sale day. Any reserve must be stated on the entry form or in writing lodged with the Auctioneer for it to be binding.

RESPONSIBILITY OF LOTS

10. Before an item is sold it shall remain on the sale ground at the risk of the vendor. It is the responsibility of the vendor to ascertain if a lot has sold and the auctioneers are under no obligation to advise vendors if a lot is sold or unsold.
11. Any lot remaining on the sale yard for 1 month without the consent of the Auctioneers will be considered abandoned and the Auctioneer is authorised to offer the lot without reserve at the next sale.

VAT

12. Where a vendor does not advise the Auctioneers of the vat status for a lot the Auctioneer will apply the rate appropriate from the information supplied and no liability will be accepted for any errors arising from this action.

REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS, MANUALS AND DETACHABLE EQUIPMENT

13. The vendor shall provide all registration documents, manuals, keys, PTO shafts and other detachable equipment at the time of entry or by 9am on the sale day at the latest.

PAYMENT

15. Payment will be made to the vendor 10 working days after the sale.
16. The Auctioneers reserve the right to withhold payment to the vendor pending adjudication on a complaint arising under the Conditions of Sale.
