Auctioneer J Turner. 'A good level trade today but affected by increased numbers of hogs out across other UK markets. Overall average of 198p/Kg or £82 per head. A large number of heavy and overweight hogs dampened the pence per Kg average and proved harder to find homes for.

Lightweight hogs however finding a good trade topping at 265p/Kg, amongst these were a lovely run of cheviot hogs from J Shorrock, Cliviger weighing 35Kg and selling at £75 per head or 214p/Kg, also S Barker, Airtton with a run of 38Kg Hogs fetching £78 per head or 205p/Kg.

Horned hogs from K Slater, Chipping sold to his advantage twice over achieving 205p/Kg at 38Kg for his Scotch Blackface hogs to Birtwistles, Worsley and Kepak, Wakefield.

A good entry of best quality Beltex and Texel hogs still selling strong were topped by Procters farms at £110 per head or 269p/Kg for their 41Kg hogs to agent D Stamper, Chipping.
