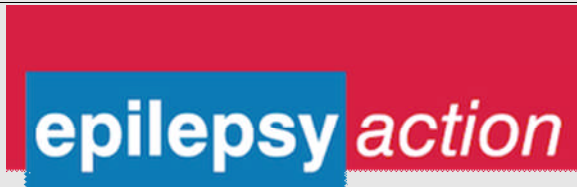
### 195 BORDER FINE ARTS & MISC
