Yesterday's rain did just enough to stop short term panic over the keep situation. There were a lot less cows and calves on offer with cautious trade continuing. Top price came from a smart Blonde heifer with heifer calf at foot selling at £1300.

Store bulls were good to sell and with some very young animals on offer a top price of £840 was a good result.

Steers and heifers for short keep were a dream to sell, often exceeding vendors' expectations. Top price of £1210 for a very strong Limousin heifer from C Oakes reflected the demand for well fleshed cattle.

A run of quality Limousin heifers and steers from R Whitfield sold to £1220 for steers and £1180 for heifers with more on offer in a fortnight.

Younger cattle continue to be the main victims of the current weather and are hard to sell at a respectable price.
